CRMC Championship presented by Gertens

PGA TOUR Canada – Fortinet Cup August 28 - September 3, 2023

Tournament Overview:	This is the second year that the CRMC Championship presented by Gerte has been held at Cragun's Legacy Courses at the Cragun's Resort.		
	The PGA TOUR Canada plays the tournament on the Blue/White layout of the Dutch Course. This is the final stop prior to the limited-field Fortinet Cup Championship, its final season-culminating event. The top-60 players on the Fortinet Cup standings following the CRMC Championship will be eligible to compete. The top Fortinet Cup points earner at the end of the season is named Player of the Year, will win an additional \$25,000 and earn full membership on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour. Players finishing in the second-through-fifth positions earn conditional Korn Ferry Tour membership.

Fortinet Cup:	The season-long points chase mirrors the competitive structure of the points-based competitions on the PGA TOUR, PGA TOUR Champions and PGA TOUR Latinoamérica. Through the sponsorship, the Fortinet Cup offers a \$100,000 player bonus pool—with \$25,000 to the winner—to the top Fortinet Cup points-winners.
